

Digging Deeper Sermon Review: June 5, 2022

Group Check-in

Open with prayer and follow up from the previous meeting. Feel free to utilize the following if they are helpful:

- Check in on past prayer requests, evidence of grace, and things for which to be grateful.
- How's your soul this week?
 - What's been hard?
 - Where is sin alluring/tempting?
 - Where is God at work in your life?
 - Where has God been good to you this past week?
 - Who are the unbelievers you are praying for?
 - Did you have any gospel opportunities in the past week?

Dig Deeper into the Sermon: Don't Quench the Spirit (1Th 5:19-22)

Have someone read Sunday's text. Consider working through some of the following questions as a group:

- Why does God tell us through the Apostle Paul to not guench the Spirit?
- Why does Paul put quenching the Spirit and despising prophecy together?
- What does it look like for you to "earnestly desire" the spiritual gifts?
 - What does it look like for the church to "earnestly desire"?
- Did you find Rick's exposition of 1 Corinthians 13:8-12 helpful in explaining why we are continuationists at CCC?
 - o If so, how did it help?
 - o If not, why?

- What did Rick mean when he said that we want to be a word and power church at Cornerstone?
- Please define the New Testament gift of prophecy?
- What is the purpose of the gift?
- What makes the prophetic gift unique when considering Christian speech?
- What does Paul mean when he refers to a prophetic report as "a revelation"?
- How should you test prophecies?
 - What makes a prophecy "good"?
 - How could a "prophecy" be evil?
- How is New Testament prophecy different from Old Testament prophecy (and New Testament Apostleship)?
- In what ways can we discover if we have this gift?
- How does the gospel bear on the gift of prophecy?

Wrap up with Prayer

Consider ways in which you can pray for one another in light of the direction the Spirit has led your discussion time.
